Artist bio:

Ori Ehrman, a musician, woodwind instruments player (saxophone, flute, clarinet and recorders...), composer, and arranger. in 2012 attended Rimon School of Jazz and Contemporary Music, Israel, and in 2016 Levinsky College, Faculty of Music Education, Israel, graduated with B.M. Ed. and in 2018 won the "Day of Jerusalem" excellence scholarship.

Since 2012 Ori has been a key member of Hayelala (an orchestrated folk music band) and Medjool (an ethno-jazz quartet) as well as playing woodwind instruments and arranging for bands as Jonz, for Studio Play (a modern and contact improvisation dancing studio) and other Israel based music productions.

through the aforementioned bands performing in a regular basis in the jazz and contemporary music scene in Israel as well as in major festivals in Israel and Europe as Fusion festival (Gr), Rudolstadt festival(Gr), Floating Castle festival(Slv), Jerusalem Culture festival in Moscow(Rus) and more. Additionally, in 2016-2018 he played in the representative ensembles of the Levinsky College: chamber music quartets and trios as a flutist, and renaissance and baroque recorders quartet as a recorder player which he also arranged for.

His main influences are classical music and jazz music which he studied in his college studies, but also folk music which he learned in workshops and personal encounters with musicians he met in his European tours, and ottoman classical music which he learned at Harel Shahal's music workshop in Israel.

Since 2019, Ori writes, arranges and records music for artistic dance projects and short movies from his own home recording studio.
